## **OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION NEW MEXICO LAND TITLE ASSOCIATION**

The objects and purposes for which the corporation is organized are:  
The advancement of the science of evidencing title to real estate property;

The promotion of the mutual advantage and general welfare of its members by the interchange of ideas and by protective, remedial and other measures to further the common interests of its members and the general public, in harmony with their respective rights, interests and duties;

To formulate and maintain ethical standards for the guidance of its members in their relation with each other and with the general public;

To do any and all things that may be incidental to, implied from or appropriate to the promotion and encouragement of these objects and purposes and to engage in any lawful act or activity pursuant thereto for which the corporation may be organized as an association not for profit under the laws of the State of New Mexico;

The corporation shall not operate or take steps which will serve to facilitate the transaction of the specific business of its members or promote private interests of any member, or engage in any activity which would constitute a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit.
